From the support of God parents in patenkinder matara e.v. First, we bought the materials for dry rations. This time we decided the following items for dry rations sacks.

They are,

- 10kg of red raw rice,
- 01 kg of Dhal,
- 01kg of Sugar
- 02 Soya packets
- 01 packet of 100g Chili Powder
- 01 packet of 100g Chili Pieces
- 01 packet of 100g Curry powder
- 01 packet of 100g Tea Powder
- 02 packets of table salt
- 02 Soaps



Rev.thero bought everything we need before two days. With the help of our students' parents, we prepared the dry ration sacks the day before the decided day (05<sup>th</sup> September). First, they measured 1kg of dhal. They made 300 dhal sacks.

When it's getting evening, we can complete our mission.

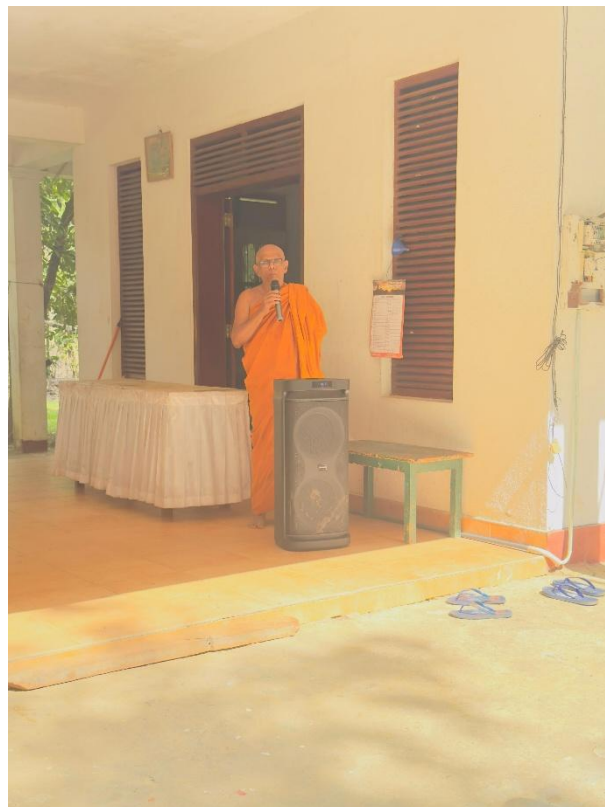
