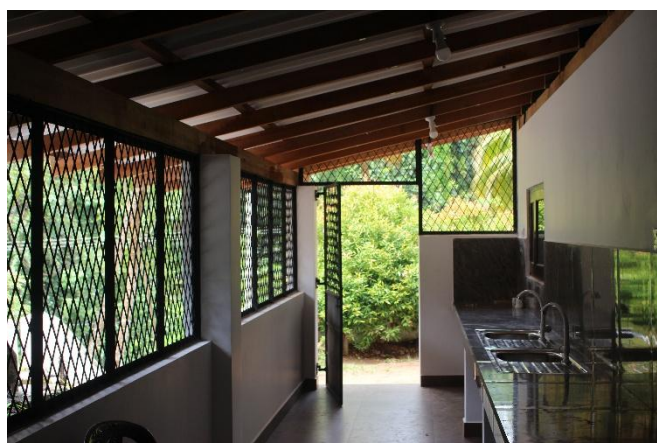

Until all the work in the kitchen was completed, all that work was done under the fall supervision of the government.
